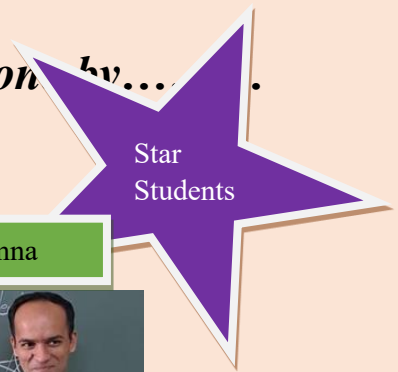
### Energy Audit:


